In July of 2021, we received a call from a citizen in Punta Gorda, who had a hold of an injured dog believed to have been hit by a car. When Officer Juergenson arrived on scene, the dog’s right rear leg appeared to be dangling and his rear left paw was swollen. X-rays were done at a local vet, and the dog’s right rear leg was found to be fractured as well as a toe on his other side. Orthopedic surgery was performed to repair his leg and “Termite” was adopted out to a loving home.
